Common Interests and Agreement

SDLINC and VISTAS after having assessed their strengths, merits and objectives have agreed that they could cooperate and share the expertise and facilities available with both. It is felt that a MOU can be drawn and entered into this agreement to their mutual intentions and are aiming to evolve cooperation between the two Institutions to develop and promote teaching, on the job training and research and the details are portrayed into this MoU for future reference.

Based on the experience of past interactions between SDLINC and VISTAS, specific areas have been identified.

MOU between SDLINC and VISTAS

The MOU between SDLINC and VISTAS envisages agreed interaction in the following

1. SDLINC and VISTAS shall be responsible for the conduct of their assigned responsibilities.

Neither SDLINC nor VISTAS shall be responsible to the other parties for any losses that they may suffer arising out of the understanding.


The parties shall be responsible for insuring their respective premises, equipment and personnel for any claims that may arise from the conduct of the understanding.

2. SDLINC agrees to share the knowledge resources with VISTAS by resource persons from SDLINC in technical seminars, conferences and workshops etc., conducted at the premises of VISTAS for the purpose of enhancing the knowledge/skill levels of the students studying in the college.
3. SDLINC agrees to impart their students in plant training conducted in SDLINC premises or VISTAS Arranged Premises at subsidized Training cost and Nominal Examination and Certification cost as case to case basis to the extent possible for the purpose of Employable skill update to their students and the traveling expenses, stay and food arrangements during the in-plant/industrial training shall be borne by the respective student.

4. In the In-plant training, the students will be imparted training on basics of Campus to Corporate Production and Quality Process Engineering Product and Process System and Continual Improvement Design and Development and Product Life Cycle.
5. The students deputed for the training courses as mentioned in paragraph 4 above will ensure that the security of SDLINC is not hampered.
6. SDLINC shall not bear any expenditure for the above industrial in-plant training courses.
7. No stipend shall be paid by SDLINC for the above training.
8. The students deputed by the VISTAS for the in-plant training shall not claim any right for appointment in SDLINC.
9. SDLINC agrees to conduct regular specialized Employable Technical Skills training courses/Workshops to the students of VISTAS on as per the rates as per the orders from SDLINC HQ and prevailing from time to time.
10. SDLINC will also arrange for Panel Discussions with Industry Experts with the students of VISTAS for facilitating better Industry-Academia relationship.
11. SDLINC will conduct regular Designations and Competitions at VISTAS with Rewards which are open to the students of VISTAS and also other colleges near their vicinity.
12. SDLINC will conduct special Internship drives at VISTAS from time to time and will show preference for VISTAS students. However, the selection for Internship is solely based on merit only.
13. SDLINC reserves the right to pay stipends for the Internships who successfully pass their probation. The students will be paid a fixed amount as stipend for the duration of the internship as mutually agreed between parties and accepted by students in writing.
14. SDLINC also reserves the right to offer Pre-Placement Offer to any of the students who are pursuing successful Internship with SDLINC if it deems the student fit to join its team and Its Industrial Client Base and Partner Companies as applicable.

15. As mentioned in above paragraph, SDLINC nor any of its associates will not conduct any campus placement interviews at VISTAS related to recruitment of fresher's in SDLINC due to its existing recruitment policy. If there is any change to such policy in the future, it will be duly notified to the respective authorities here at VISTAS.
16. SDLINC will facilitate through its many partners or in its sole capacity, incubation of ideas of Students exclusive to VISTAS. Top Innovations will be chosen from students (First to third year) of engineering and the idea will be incubated as a product and there is a possibility of it being converted into another startup/venture as part of SDLINC Entrepreneurship program. SDLINC reserves all rights of vetting.
17. As discussed in above paragraph, SDLINC will also chose Top Projects from the Final Year VISTAS Students and the best ones will be incubated as a commercial project. SDLINC reserves all rights of vetting through proper permissions from VISTAS.
18. To conduct Workshops/Training and Organize Industrial visit to the students of the VISTAS for a subsidized cost.
19. To evolve specialized training programmes and courses to be offered in a collaborative manner.
20. To expertise of the Faculty/Engineers of both the institutions in the common academic endeavours.
21. To share the expertise, laboratory, Class Room, Conference Hall and the instrumental facilities of both the institutions for common programmes without affecting the regular activities of the respective institutions as part of Revenue generation model programs for mutual Benefits.
22. To Exchange of any other facilities mutually acceptable to both in view of curriculum development.
23. To assist in placement and consultancy work.
24. This agreement will be effective upon the signing this MoU by both parties and remain in effect for Three years. Either party may terminate the MoU by giving to the other party 30 days notice in writing.
