The GATE 2018 score is calculated using the formula

$$\text{GATE Score} = S_g + (S_c - S_g) \frac{(M - M_g)}{(M_c - M_g)}$$

where,

 M is the marks obtained by the candidate in the paper, mentioned on this GATE 2018 scorecard M_g is the qualifying marks for general category candidate in the paper M_c is the mean of marks of top 0.1% or top 10 (whichever is larger) of the candidates who appeared in the paper (in case of multi-session papers including all sessions) $S_g = 350$, is the score assigned to M_g $S_c = 900$, is the score assigned to M_c In the GATE 2018 score formula, M_g is 25 marks (out of 100) or $\mu + \sigma$, whichever is greater. Here μ is the mean and σ is the standard deviation of marks of all the candidates who appeared in the paper.

Qualifying in GATE 2018 does not guarantee either an admission to a post-graduate program or a scholarship/assistantship. Admitting institutes may conduct further tests and interviews for final selection.
