All the above listed members attended the meeting and discussed extensively on the curriculum and syllabus in detail. The following are the recommendations of the Committee on the subject matter.

B.Sc. Biochemistry (Three years, Six Semesters)

1. Title of the course Biomolecules to be changed to "Introduction to Biomolecules".
2. Inclusion of "Structure and function of chloroplasts" in the course Cell Biology and "Properties of carbohydrates" in the course Introduction to Biomolecules.
3. Introduction of topics on Kwashiorkar and Marasmus in the course "Clinical Nutrition".
4. Regulation of Glucose metabolism may be included in Enzymes and Intermediary Metabolism paper.

M.Sc Advanced Biochemistry/ M.Sc Biochemistry (Two years, Four Semesters)

1. The title may be revised to M.Sc Biochemistry instead of M.Sc Advanced Biochemistry
2. Inclusion of a topic "Biosensors for management of diabetes" in the course Advanced Instrumental Techniques.
3. Inclusion of a topic titled "Importance of EFAs" in the course Chemistry of Biomolecules has been suggested.
4. Few more minor modifications were duly suggested in the courses Human Physiology and Basics of Anatomy (Inclusion of respiration studies in detail), Enzymes (changes in the Unit pertaining to Coenzymes).

5. Enzymology Practicals may include Salivary Amylase and any one Phosphatase instead of both phosphatases.

The revised and modified Syllabus for B.Sc Biochemistry and M.Sc Biochemistry may be introduced from the academic year 2015-2016 and placed before the appropriate bodies for their approval.
